#### **About the Role**

Children's Health Defense Australia are seeking highly motivated and skilled individuals to join our team as Community Ambassadors. In this role, you will be a critical voice in supporting Children's Health Defense Australia's mission to end the epidemics of chronic illness in children by eliminating harmful toxic exposures, holding those responsible accountable, and establishing safeguards so that this never happens again. You will be responsible for building relationships with community members, promoting CHD AU events and initiatives, and advocating for our cause. This is a volunteer position that requires a commitment of approximately 10 hours per month, though this time varies dependent on need.

- Build and maintain relationships with community members, other health freedom organisations, and local leaders.
- Promote our Children's Health Defense Australia events, initiatives, and campaigns to increase community involvement and support.

- Collaborate with other volunteers and staff members to achieve Children's Health Defense Australia's goals, initiatives and campaigns.
- Attend regular information sessions and meetings to stay informed about our Children's Health Defense Australia's mission, values, and initiatives.
